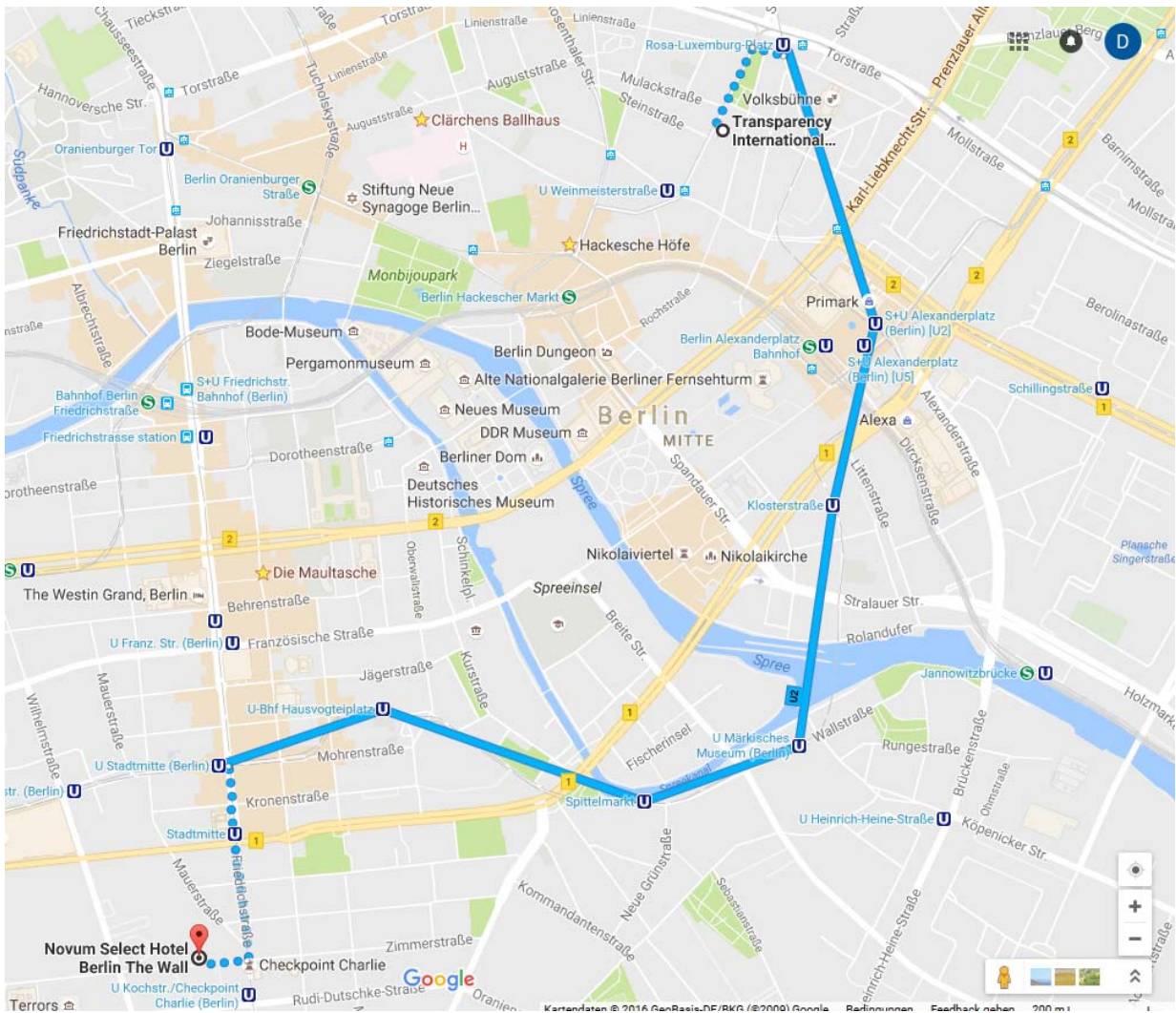

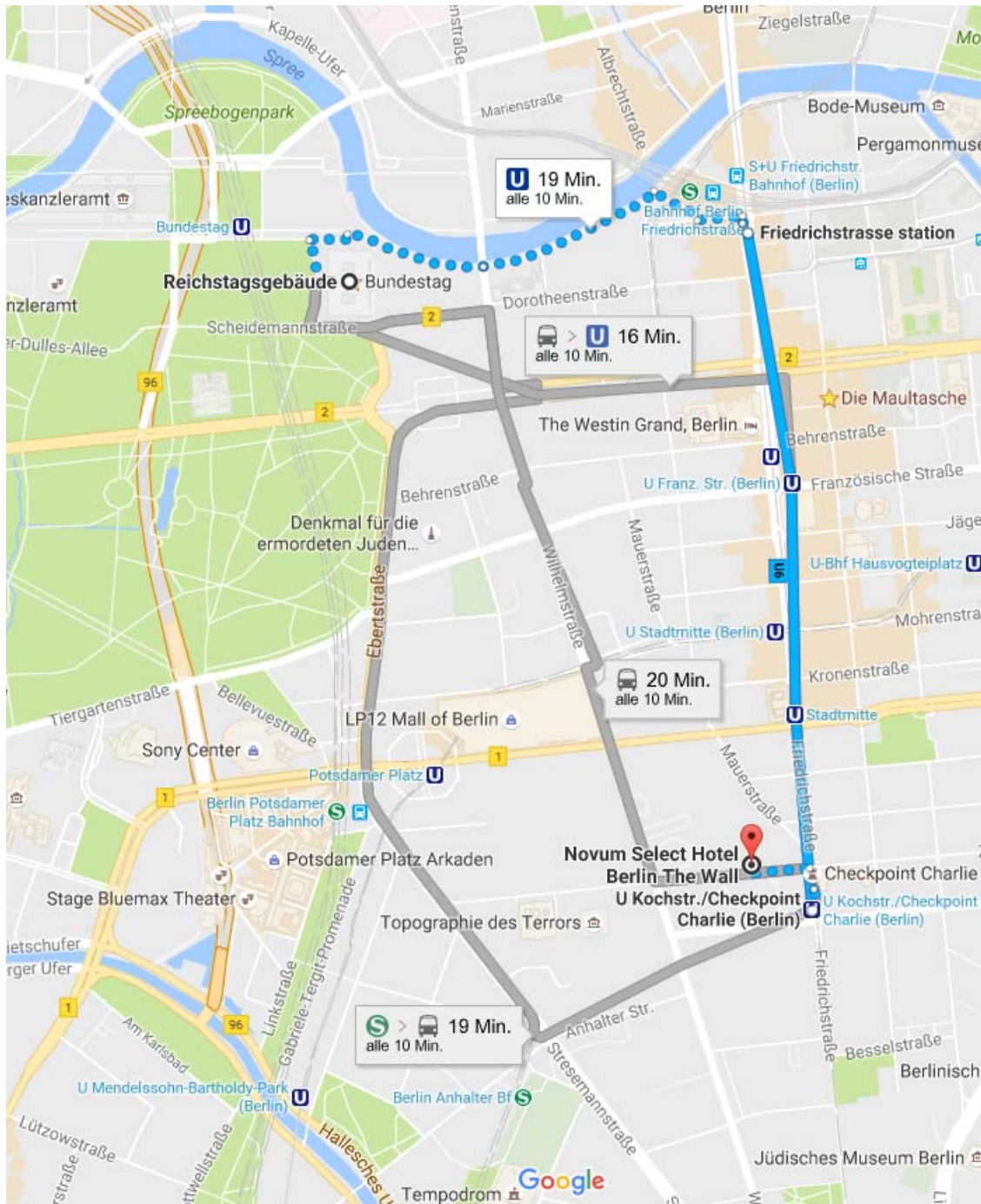
Monday evening – Way from Transparency International to the Hotel:

Subway – U6 from Friedrichstraße – Direction: Alt-Mariendorf – to: Kochstraße / Checkpoint Charlie

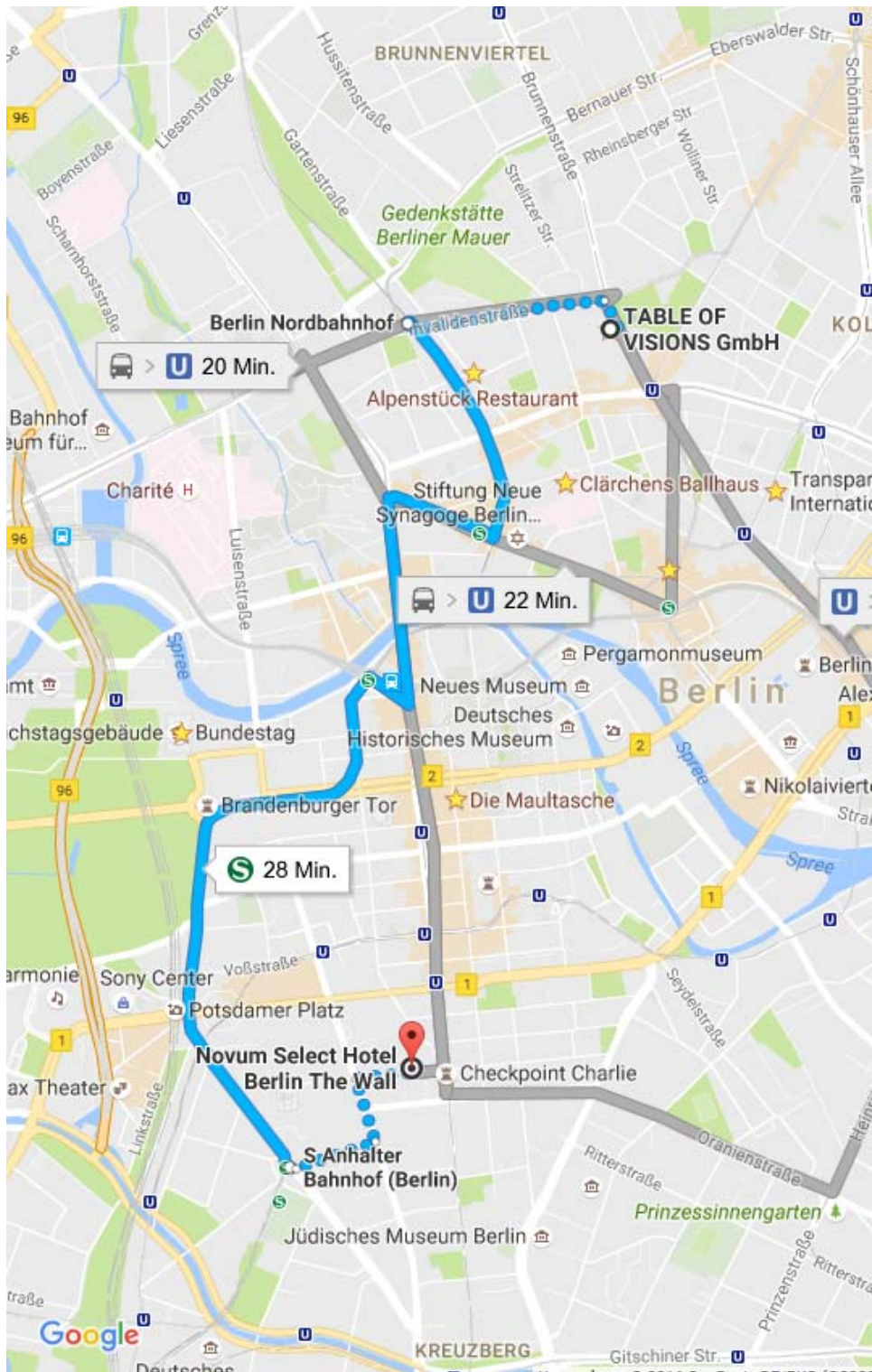


Thursday afternoon – Way from Table of Visions to the hotel:
